Christchurch Spire (also known as Christchurch Steeple) is a historic Grade II* listed building located on New Union Street in the city centre of Coventry. Standing at 211 feet (approx. 64 metres) tall, it is famous for being the shortest of Coventry's iconic "Three Spires", alongside Holy Trinity Church and the ruins of St Michael's Cathedral. Today, the preserved medieval structure has been given a unique new lease of life, operating as an atmospheric café and bar
