Coventry Cathedral St Michael



The Coventry Cathedral Ruins (the shell of the 14th-century Cathedral Church of St Michael) stand as a world-famous symbol of peace, survival, and reconciliation. Located in the heart of Coventry, the medieval hallowed grounds were left intact as an open-air memorial after being destroyed by fire during World War II. Today, they sit directly adjacent to the striking New Cathedral consecrated in 1962.
