World Cup Moments

8 - Marco Tardelli is famous for his performance in the 1982 FIFA World Cup, where he helped Italy win the tournament and delivered one of the most iconic goal celebrations in football history, known as the "Tardelli Scream"

9 - The most famous photo of Diego Maradona surrounded by players is the iconic 1982 World Cup image, often misinterpreted as him being swarmed by six Belgian defenders. However, this legendary photograph—often called "The Magician"—captures the moment he received a short free-kick, with the players rushing forward from a defensive wall.

10 - "The Hand of God" is the name given to the opening goal awarded to Argentine footballer Diego Maradona during Argentina's victory over England in a quarter-final match at the 1986 FIFA World Cup. The goal, which was illegal under association football rules, was allowed to stand because none of the match referees could see Maradona using his left hand to score.

11 – Roger Milla - He achieved international stardom at 38 years old, an age at which most forwards have retired, by scoring four goals at the 1990 FIFA World Cup, becoming the oldest goalscorer in World Cup history at the time. He helped Cameroon become the first African team to reach the World Cup quarter-finals.

12 - Lothar Herbert Matthäus is a German football pundit and former professional player and manager. He captained West Germany to victory in the 1990 FIFA World Cup and was awarded the Ballon d'Or.

13 - Paul Gascoigne's tears during the 1990 FIFA World Cup semi-final against West Germany are one of the most iconic moments in English football history. The heartbreak occurred after he received a yellow card. Having already been booked in the tournament, the caution meant he would be suspended from the final should England advance

14 - Oleg Salenko is a Russian striker famous for setting a FIFA World Cup record at the 1994 tournament in the USA by scoring five goals in a single match against Cameroon. He finished the tournament with six goals, sharing the Golden Boot with Hristo Stoichkov, despite Russia being eliminated in the group.

15 - USA 1994 ended as it had began: with a wayward penalty. On 17 July, exactly a month on from Diana Ross's comical miss in the opening ceremony, Roberto Baggio took aim from 12 yards. He did so knowing that failure to hit the net would consign Italy to defeat in the FIFA World Cup™ final and confirm Brazil as champions.
